In the last Kappeler Institute Newsletter #11, we have dealt with the question: What is Evil? from the standpoint of the 4 levels of Science. In this Newsletter, we will continue with our study of the 4 levels of Science, but now through the consideration of the question: What is healing?

ow does an understanding of the levels of Science apply to the healing work? ... At present a few fundamentals hints may be helpful.

Science itself

There is nothing to be healed. In the face of error, the level of Science itself takes the attitude: "I do not know you; you are completely unknown to me." The consciousness of Science knows no disease, no inharmony of any sort; it has nothing to heal. "Science knows no lapse from nor return to harmony" (S&H 471:1), in it "all is one grand concord" (S&H 240:11) and all has "remained unchanged in its eternal history" (S&H 471:4). The highest method of healing is a consciousness of wholeness, an understanding that there is nothing to be healed.



Divine Science

Instantaneous healing. In the oneness of divine Science, error is excluded. It is an attitude of consciousness in which error is not going to be excluded—which would need a time process—but *is* excluded; the everpresent perfection is realized. In divine Science, all healing is instantaneous. Jesus healed in divine Science, and so did Mrs. Eddy; her healings were usually instantaneous and seldom with more than one treatment.

Absolute Christian Science

Preventive practice. In the first place, the root of all inharmonies should be healed, namely, the belief that there is something at work besides ideas and their operations. Latent error has to be healed rather than a disease. The infinite calculus of ideas in absolute Christian Science gives us that consciousness which corrects those deeply rooted, conscious and especially unconscious, collective and universal beliefs that are the source of all visible forms of inharmony, and thus prevent us from becoming ill. It is prophylactic practice.

Christian Science

Healing practice. Christian Science explains the modus operandi of healing, the therapeutic practice; it teaches the rules of bodily healing through the divine Mind, and how and why Truth can save us from disease and death.

Divine Cybernetics

God, divine Principle, Love's law of self-organization

The following article is composed of edited excerpts derived from Max Kappeler's recording: "A Survey of the Fundamentals of Christian Science" Talk, Boston, MA (Tape code B-1, hours 9–10)—KI Editors.

In "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy we read:

[Science itself] "From the infinite One in Christian Science [divine Science] comes one Principle and its infinite idea, and [absolute Christian Science] with this infinitude come spiritual rules, laws, [Christian Science] and their demonstration...." (112:16–19)

From this statement we can see clearly how God, the one infinite Being, heals:

Science itself the one infinite Being

divine Science as a self-organizing system, running on a self-regulating circuit of divine

Christian Science has positive feedback (error-preventing laws and rules)

Christian Science as well as "negative" feedback (self-correction of the belief in error)

In divine Science we witness that the one infinite Being (Science itself) becomes a self-operating, self-organizing system running on a self-regulating circuit of divine oneness of divine Principle and its idea. In other words, the one infinite Being operates by itself. This self-movement is called divine cybernetics. This lifts the burden off our shoulders that we have to do something in order to make Being/being work. All we need to do is to let Being operate itself—to let it happen.

(i) Divine Cybernetics continued

Cybernetics comes from the Greek kybernetes, meaning pilot, governor, or to steer or govern. In modern usage, it means "the science of communication and control theory that is concerned especially with the comparative study of automatic control systems" (Langenscheidt New College Merriam-Webster English Dictionary). In the Science of Christian Science, the term "divine cybernetics" refers to the one divine Principle, Love, that governs the universe, including mankind. Mrs. Eddy shows this in her statement:


"What are termed in common speech the principle of harmonious vibration, the principle of conservation of number in geometry, the principle of the inclined plane in mechanics, etc., are but an effect of one universal cause,—an emanation of the one divine intelligent Principle that holds the earth in its orbit by evolved spiritual power, that commands the waves and the winds, that marks the sparrow's fall, and that governs all from the infinitesimal to the infinite,—namely, God. Withdraw God, divine Principle, from man and the universe, and man and the universe would no longer exist. But annihilate matter, and man and the universe would remain the forever fact, the spiritual 'substance of things hoped for;' and the evidence of the immortality of man and the cosmos is sustained by the intelligent divine Principle, Love.

"Beloved students, in this you learn to hallow His name, even as you value His all-power, all-presence, all-Science, and depend on Him for your existence." (Miscellany 226:6–23)

It is divine cybernetics that shows us that only the one divine Principle, Love, is ruling the universe. If we do not consciously accept this one self-operating Principle that is moving and controlling all levels of experience, then we appear to live in a "diverse," in a dualistic universe of good and evil, health and sickness, and so on.

New Book!

When I Think of John W. Doorly...II Introduction to the Matrix-Consciousness

Max Kappeler's teacher, John W. Doorly, CSB (London), discovered the fundamental system of the Science of Christian Science within the Bible and the Christian Science textbook, "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy. This system consists of 3 main categories:

- 1. The 7 synonymous terms for God (Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, Love), which define the *nature of God*.
- 2. The 4-fold operation of God (Word, Christ, Christianity, Science), derived from the four sides of the Holy City, which describes *how God operates*.
- 3. The 4 levels of spiritual consciousness (Science itself, divine Science, absolute Christian Science, Christian Science), which describe the *dimensional aspect of God*.

Doorly was able to show the interrelationships between the first two categories in the form of a matrix.

For many years, Max Kappeler has repeatedly presented this matrix-structure in his lectures. He has refined the structure of the matrix and polished the tonality of the categorial interrelationships. The result is this book—a lively and practical introduction to working with matrices, which are indispensable tools for understanding Science. Students will gain a deeper insight into the interaction of the 7 synonymous terms for God in their fundamental orders within the 4 modes of operation—a good example of the mutual reflection of the ontological categories that the Christian Science textbook calls "the divine infinite calculus" (S&H 520).
